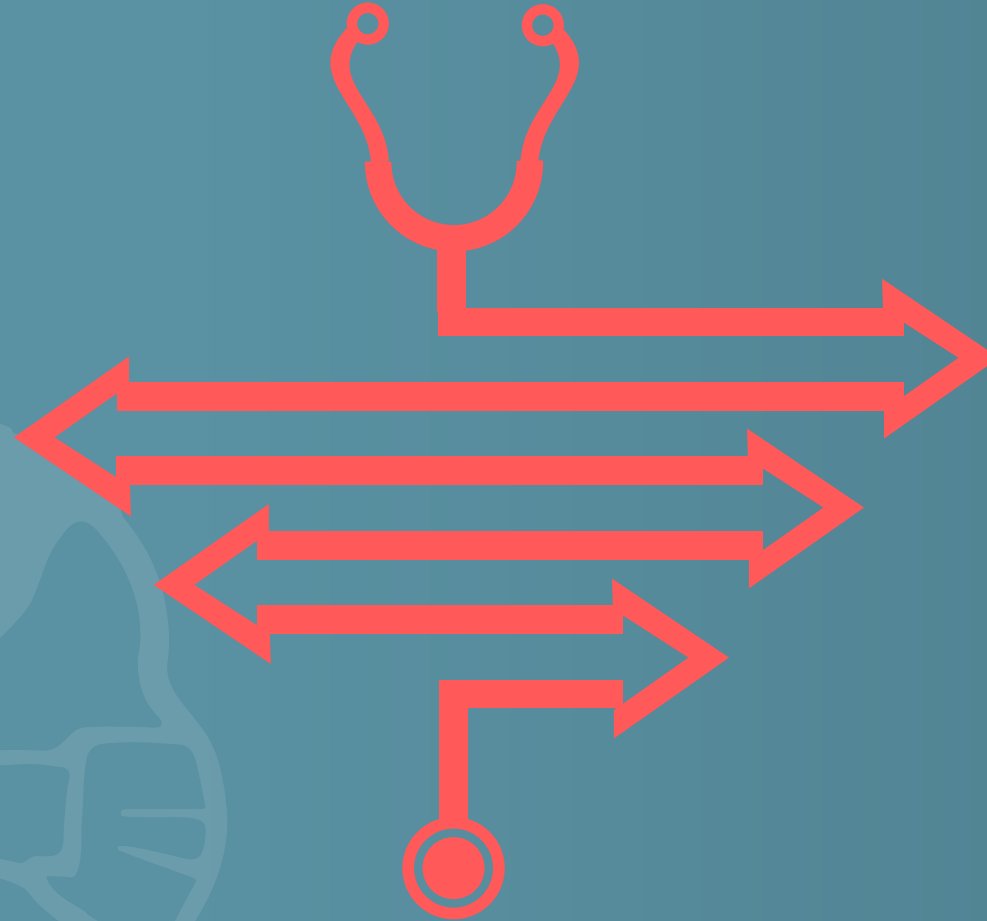

Part II & IV Functions of the Director- General

7(c) To acquire records and materials which in the opinion of the Director General are or are likely to be permanent or enduring national or historical value or both

Acquisition of non-public records

31. The Director General may acquire any record not being public record which in his opinion are or are likely to be permanent or enduring national or historical value or both

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 4 -- A 41-year-old man is the first Malaysian who has tested positive for the novel coronavirus 2019 (2019-nCoV).

He is one of two new positive cases, bringing to 10 the number of coronavirus cases in Malaysia so far.

Health Minister Datuk Seri Dr Dzulkefly Ahmad said the other case involved a 63-year-old man from China who arrived at the KL International Airport on Jan 18.

UPDATES ON THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) SITUATION IN MALAYSIA

Current Situation of COVID-19 in Malaysia

13 March 2020, 12 pm – A total of **39 additional confirmed COVID-19 cases** were reported to the National Crisis Preparedness and Response Centre (CPRC) Ministry of Health (MOH) today. These cases have all been identified and placed in isolation for further management.

With these additional 39 cases, cumulatively there are now **197 confirmed COVID-19 cases** in Malaysia. Of these additional confirmed cases:

- 38 cases are amongst Patients Under Investigation (PUI); and
- One (1) case amongst close contacts.

Currently, four (4) cases are reported to be in the intensive care units requiring ventilation support. They have all received anti-viral medications.

The first wave of COVID-19 infection in Malaysia involved 22 confirmed COVID-19 cases (Cases 1 to 22). Of these, 12 cases were amongst PUI, 8 cases amongst close contacts and 2 cases amongst the Humanitarian Assistance mission evacuees from Hubei, China. All cases from the first wave have fully recovered and discharged well.

For the second wave of COVID-19 infection (Cases 23 to 197): of these 52

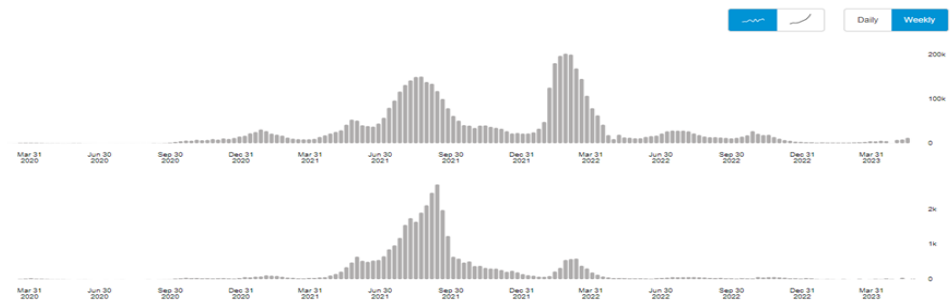
In **Malaysia**, from **3 January 2020 to 6:07pm CEST, 31 May 2023**, there have been **5,100,249 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 with **37,087 deaths**, reported to WHO. As of **13 May 2023**, a total of **72,622,256 vaccine doses** have been administered.

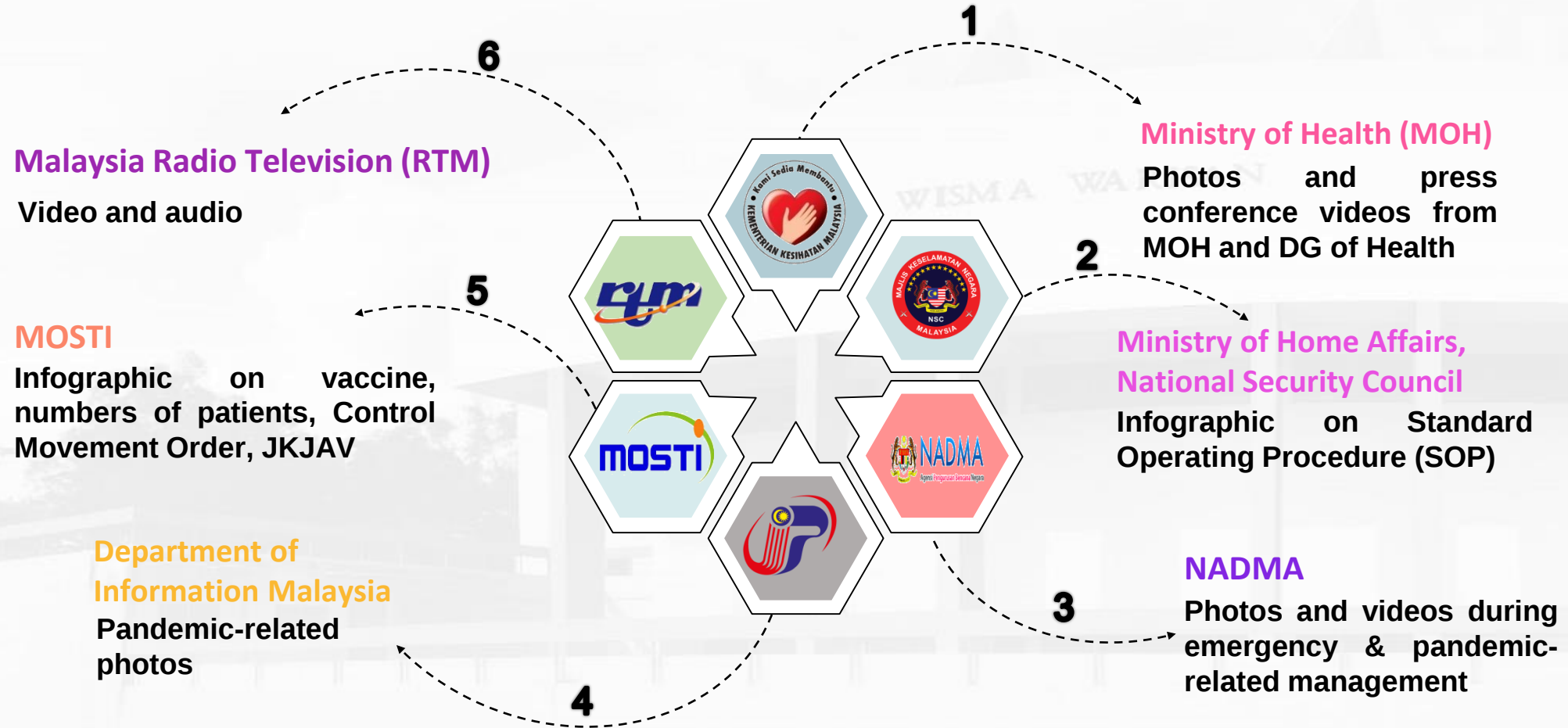


PUSAT KUARANTIN DAN RAWATAN BERISIKO RENDAH (PKRC)

PKRC adalah antara keperluan bagi memastikan penularan Covid-19 dapat diputuskan dan pengurusan Covid-19 yang lebih sistematik. Pada fasa pertama Covid-19 di Labuan, hanya sebuah PKRC dibuka iaitu melibatkan bangunan Asrama Jururawat, Hospital Labuan dengan kapasiti 100 katil. Walau bagaimanapun, disebabkan peningkatan kes yang sangat ketara pada serangan gelombang ke-2, tiga lagi PKRC dibuka iaitu di Dewan Perbadanan Labuan dengan kapasiti 146 katil, asrama Institut Teknologi Latihan Perindustrian (ILP) dengan kapasiti 299 katil dan Asrama Bahagian Teknologi Pendidikan WP Labuan dengan kapasiti 80 katil menjadikan jumlah keseluruhan katil di semua PKRC adalah 625 katil. Kesemua PKRC kecuali PKRC Asrama Jururawat dan PKRC ILP telah ditutup selepas gelombang kedua reda. Namun, sewaktu gelombang ketiga Covid-19, kesemua PKRC di Labuan dibuka semula bagi menampung peningkatan kes yang sangat ketara.

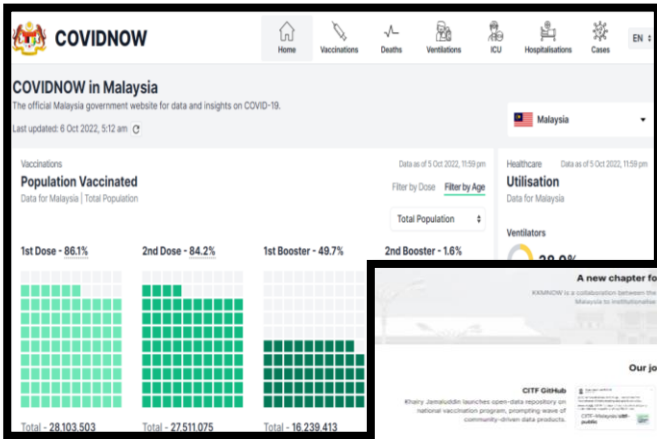

Sustain the objective of acquisition by conducting continuous study to identify records related to Malaysia i.e events, global involvement, emergency

RETRIEVE & RESEARCH

Retrieve private records from individual and non-governmental organizations



MAKE

Promote and develop cooperation with non-governmental institutions, individuals within and outside the country

ADDRESS

Address the current issue by providing archival materials for research purposes

TELL

Tell and inform the public as part of an ongoing mission to provide the public with research resources
