APPROACH

- **Teacher-education projects and activities**
 - Student teachers and teachers
- **Classroom units of instruction on work and role of archives**
 - High and low achievers
 - Local history
- **Exhibition and visits**
- **Projects involving students in archival research**
 - Group work





APPROACH

- **The production of archives-based teaching kits**
- **The use of students to identify and collect materials of interest to archives**
 - **Family history**
 - **Local history/history of the school**
- **The formation of school-based archives**
 - **Develop students sensitivity**
- **The establishment of organizational linkages between teachers and archivists**



ARCHIVISTS AND EDUCATORS

- **Archivists get themselves on the mailing list**
- **Archivists represented in curriculum committees**
- **Archivists work out in-service programmes for teachers**
- **Work with teachers' federations as resource providers**
